<p>Nursery</p>	<p><u>Early Experiences</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Make a mud pie • Visit a farm • Kick the leaves on an Autumn walk • Feed the ducks at the duck pond • Play in the park on the swings, slide and roundabout • Post a letter <p>Nursery children will develop their understanding of their local area, and have their first experience of a new environment when they visit the farm.</p>
<p>Reception</p>	<p><u>Using all our senses</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Run around in the rain • Draw in the sand on the beach • Walk outside barefoot • Jump over waves • Play in the snow • Visit the theatre to watch a play <p>Reception children will experience the great outdoors in all weathers to develop their understanding of the senses. They will also visit a theatre to see a familiar tale performed.</p>
<p>Year 1</p>	<p><u>Explore the great outdoors</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Hunt for bugs • Climb a huge hill • Play pooh sticks • Roll down a really big hill • Explore inside an old tree • Paddle in a stream • Dam a stream <p>Year 1 children will be introduced to the countryside in regular visits and will be encouraged to become increasingly adventurous.</p>
<p>Year 2</p>	<p><u>Seaside explorer</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fly a kite • Explore a rock pool • Catch a crab • Roll down a sand dune • Paddle in the waves • Build a sandcastle <p>Year 2 children will get to know the beaches closest to their home – developing skills and using imagination when spending a day on the beach.</p>

<p>Year 3</p>	<p><u>Investigate a pond</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Find some frog spawn • Catch a fish with a net • Discover what’s in a pond • Plant it, grow it, eat it • Cook on a camp fire <p>Year 3 children will learn all about life in a pond and will plan their own exploration. They will also grow and cook their own food and plan a café to serve it in.</p> <p>Year 3 children will also:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visit a restaurant and order from the menu
<p>Year 4</p>	<p><u>Wildlife all around us</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Climb a tree • Build a den • Track wild animals • Hunt for fossils and bones • Look after a butterfly • Go bird watching • Make a trail with sticks • Make a home for a wild animal • Set up a snail race <p>Year 4 children will learn to enjoy getting muddy in the countryside – using their imagination to play in the forest and learning to care for living things.</p> <p>Year 4 children will also:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Learn to play a musical instrument • Watch a concert
<p>Year 5</p>	<p><u>Become an explorer</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Camp out in the wild • Pick blackberries growing in the wild and eat them • Make a daisy chain • Go star gazing • Play conkers • Go on a nature walk at midnight • Find your way with a map and compass • Canoe down a river <p>Year 5 children will learn skills throughout the year that prepare them for a night under canvas.</p> <p>Year 5 children will also:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visit another country • Perform in a theatre

Year 6	<p><u>Responsibility – using our skills</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Go on a really long bike ride• Skim a stone• Make a grass trumpet• Explore a cave• Hold a scary beast• Build a raft• Try rock climbing• Learn to ride a horse <p>Year 6 children will take part in a series of adventurous ‘new’ experiences over the year in small groups.
